In the beginning was God. God always existed - He was never born. God lived in the perfect place, the place we call the Kingdom of Light.

Gold/yellow reminds us of heaven, the Kingdom of Light.

John 1:1  
Colossians 1:13

God chose to create Earth. Our planet was so amazing that God said: "it is good". And then he created people to live on the planet, and they were so amazing that God said, "it is very good." God also says this of you: You are His very good creation. And people lived with God on this beautiful planet that he made.

Green reminds us of the amazing home God made for us.

Genesis 1

But people chose to disobey God and to go their own way. This is sin. Sin wrecked the beautiful place God made. It made sadness and fighting and sickness and death. Every one of us humans has sinned, and sin separates us from God. This brings spiritual death and real death, because death is what happens when there is no life. No God, no Life.

Black reminds us of the darkness and sadness of sin and death, sometimes called the Dominion of Darkness.

Romans 3:23  
Colossians 1:13

But God did not want this to be the end, so he made a way for you to return to Him. He sent his son, Jesus, to die on the cross to take all the consequences for your sin.

Red reminds us that because of Jesus' blood and his death, we are forgiven.

1 Cor. 15:3, 4  
1 John 1:7  
John 3:16  
Ephesians 2:8,9

Jesus didn't stay dead - he came back to life. Because he came back to life, you can have real life again too - you get to be the realest you, the person God created you to be without all that sin in the way. When you say that "Jesus is Lord" and believe that God raised him from the dead, you are saved. You are clean.

White reminds us that because of Jesus' death and resurrection, we can be clean - he washes away our dirty sin.

In this new life, God is re-creating you. He gives you the Holy Spirit to help you learn to love him and love others. You will grow with God your whole life. As you do this, you give the world a little reminder of the beautiful and incredible place it was meant to be.

Green reminds us that we grow with God and that we help the world become beautiful again.

And at the end of your life, Jesus will bring you home to the perfect place where there is no more death or sadness or sin or sickness.

Gold/Yellow reminds us of God's Kingdom of Light, and that we get to be there too.
