As our building expands, we often thank God for His provision and for growing our faith. CONSTRUCTION UPDATE







Our expansion is literally taking shape! A lot has happened with the building construction since our previous update in February when the basement walls were being poured. The main and second floors have been poured, and much of the steel structure is in place. Exterior sheeting will start to go up in late June, and the roof is scheduled to be completed by mid-July. At that point, interior work can proceed. To address a persistent groundwater issue common in this area of Beaumont, a sub-floor drainage system is being installed before the basement floor is poured. Concrete work for the steps and sidewalks will be done over the summer, and landscaping and paving will take place in late August or early September.

Despite the challenges faced last fall and the work needed to mitigate them, we are just 0.6%, or less than \$50,000, over budget on the work that is the general contractor's responsibility. We are still on track for the expansion to be complete by late fall this year.

We are grateful for everyone's patience with the inconveniences that construction brings, which of course, have been compounded by our recent flood and mould issues in our existing building and with the limited parking on Sundays.



S FINANCIAL **UPDATE**

As of May 2023, our campaign savings are at \$6.6 million, with additional commitments of \$38,000 for this current campaign year. Thank you, church family, for your faith and your financial commitment to the expansion project!

We still have significant funds to raise for the \$9.6 million expansion. We hope to have as little debt as possible when the expansion is complete, and ultimately no debt at all - because that too is possible with God leading the way.
