COMMITMENT SUNDAY OCTOBER 22, 2023

For eight years now our Eaglemont church family, and even other individuals and organizations outside of our church have been faithful and generous in giving to the Faith Expansion Capital Campaign.

The generosity and sacrifice of so many has been overwhelming and humbling. It has also been affirming to see God leading each of us through this faith journey as we commit our finances and our prayers to the building expansion.

On October 22nd, we will have our final Commitment Sunday for this phase of the campaign – before the expansion is complete. This giving opportunity is perhaps the most important one we've had in the eight years of the campaign as it will determine the level of debt we will have going forward (how much our mortgage will be).


As we have over the course of the campaign, Eaglemont leadership and the building expansion team humbly ask you to prayerfully consider how God might want you to give to the expansion vision, over and above your regular tithing. As Pastor Marlo <u>recently shared</u>, God sometimes stretches us in these matters, but He will always provide.

MAKING YOUR COMMITMENT

As with previous giving opportunities, your commitments and financial gifts toward the expansion can be one-time gifts, or a weekly, monthly or annual commitment.

With a total cost for the expansion of approximately \$10 million, \$3.3 million still needs to be raised. We hope to have as little debt as possible when the expansion is complete, and ultimately no debt at all – because that too is possible with God leading the way!

So, as you pray about what financial commitment God is leading you to make this coming year, please consider the following scenarios (note these are not final/confirmed amounts but examples of what our mortgage for the expansion may look like).

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

The progress on our building expansion has been significant since our June update, and it is exciting to see it all coming together! We've gone from a steel structure at that point to now seeing the stucco being finished on the exterior and the doors and windows installed.

As previously mentioned, some unavoidable delays in the early stages of the project have moved the completion date further than originally anticipated, but we are in the final stretch. Construction should be complete by late December, and after working through the



final details with the contractor, we hope to be in the building sometime in January.

Due to the time of year, the final landscaping will be done in the spring. We will be looking for some volunteers at that time to help with some final aspects of the expansion, so stay tuned for more information on that opportunity.

EXPANSION SNEAK PEEK

The building expansion team is excited to announce that a walk-through of the expansion will be held after the October 22 gathering. More information will be shared that morning, but we encourage our Eaglemont church family to plan to stay after the gathering and take part in the walk-through. It will be an exciting opportunity to see where construction is at and where we will be in just a few short months!
